- This project promotes the use of technology for creative outcomes.

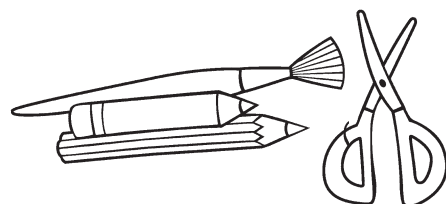
#### Wax relief and screen print workshop

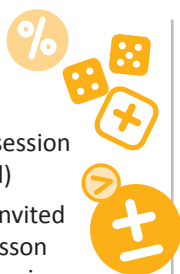
#### Scratch Workshops

# Performing arts

**Topics include:** storytelling, free running, exploring other cultures, variety shows.

- **Creativity and problem solving** – students will have to 'think on their feet/think outside the box' and approach tasks from a variety of perspectives.
- **Confidence** – dance and drama allows a student to practice stepping out of their comfort zone, to make mistakes and learn from them through rehearsal. This process gives children the confidence to perform in a variety of situations.
- **Perseverance and dedication** – through devising, performing and receiving feedback these skills evolve organically through the sessions.
- **Focus** – This is a skill needed to achieve in any subject. During group work students must keep a balance between listening/watching and contributing which involves concentration and focus. Furthermore, it requires each participant to not only think about their role, but how their role contributes to the big picture of what is being created.
- **Collaboration** – much of the work undertaken in Drama and Dance involves shared responsibility. This means that a goal is accomplished through compromise.
- Hourly sessions over 6 weeks, longer sessions available by arrangement
- Half a day session are also available.
- Visits to primary schools are also on offer – supervised visits by students to deliver a weekly session.

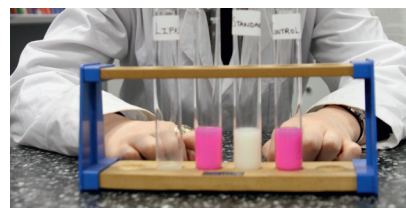
