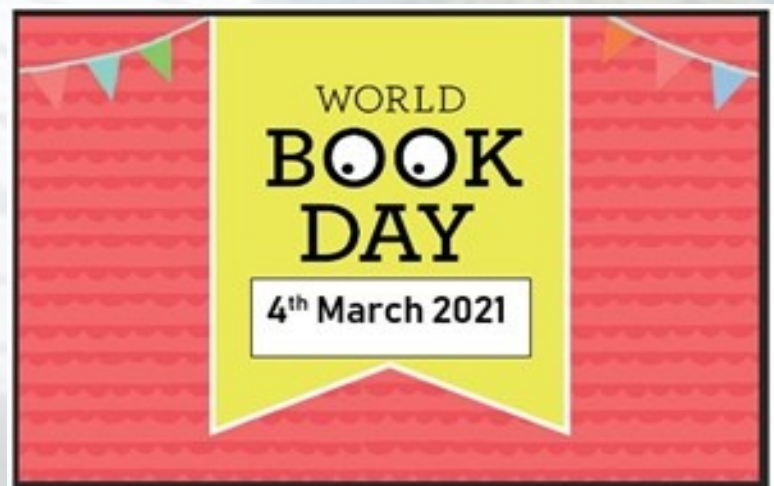


Welcome Back!

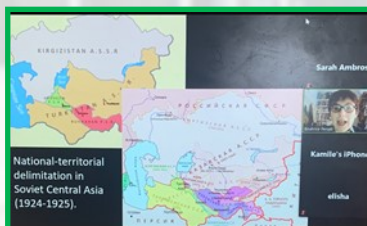

Stalin: Breaker or Maker of Nations

In History this week students were given the opportunity to attend a lecture by Dr Beatrice Penati from the University of Liverpool. 48 History Year 9-13 students from attended the lecture voluntarily and were impeccably behaved and engaged throughout.



Dr. Beatrice asked the students to check up the key watersheds in the history of Russia and the Soviet Union in the 20th century the Russian Revolution in 1917, Stalinism and World War II.

The lecture gave students a really interesting and balanced view on whether Stalin should be seen as a maker or breaker of nations.
