

Spanish

At KS4 in Spanish we follow the AQA GCSE programme.

The qualification assesses the language skills of speaking, listening, reading and writing. The exams for each skill are equally weighted and are all worth 25% of the final grade.



The course is split in to three themes, and over the two-year course pupils study the following topics;

Theme 1: Relationships with family and friends, marriage/partnerships, social media, mobile technology, music, cinema and TV, food and eating out, sport, customs and festivals in Spanish-speaking countries/communities.

Theme 2: Home, town, neighbourhood and region, social issues, charity/voluntary work, healthy/unhealthy living, the environment, poverty/homelessness, travel and tourism.

Theme 3: My studies, life at school/college, education post-16, jobs, career choices and ambitions.
